## Vaastu & Living

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THE ENTIRE UNIVERSE IS MADE UP OF FIVE ELEMENTS AND EVENTUALLY IT MERGES IN THESE ELEMENTS



The entire Universe is made up of five elements and eventually it merges in these elements. The Sun and its rays, the

cosmic energy emanating from the planets and the Earth's gravitational force are mutually related to the eight directions. As a result they influence each and every Vaastu. In short Vaastu shastra is the science that synchronises a balance between human life and nature. The five basic elements, the eight directions, the gravitational force of the earth, the cosmic energy emanating from the planets as well as the atmosphere have their influence on human life and are important factors in Vaastu shastra which when taken into consideration bring about time-fair confluence of nature and human life.

Human body is created from the five basic elements in the Universe. Our body is the abode for the soul and our building or Vaastu is the dwelling place of the body. This building dwells in nature. It is an integral part of the nature. Nature is occupied by five elements of the universe. Our body is made up of five basic elements of the Universe. It means the dwelling place (vaastu) of the body comes between the human body and nature. The exchange of the energy phenomena. It is therefore imperative that we achieve the balance between the five elements in the universe and the eight directions. It is only after this balance is achieved that we will experience the power of Mother nature. It is for this very reason that the philosophy from soul to the Universe is significant from the point of view of the

Vaastu shastra.

Whenever you are planning to invest in real estate you must take into consideration aspects of Vaastu shastra because whether you use the vaastu directly or you just buy it for investment you will be affected by the various positive and negative effects of that vaastu. In other words vaastu effects will still continue to have its impact both on the owner and the person who is living on rent.

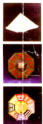
While purchasing new vaastu one has to check the following parameters viz: directions of the entrance, the living-room, kitchen, the bed-room, toilet, bathroom, the center region (Brahma region), cuts and the most important one is the abode of God which is unfortunately the most neglected in all houses. For positive and favorable results the directions for these regions should be as follows:

1. Entrance: should be either in North, North East, East, West of North West and South of South East.
2. Living Room: should be between North to East or can be in North West.
3. Kitchen: should only be in the south east.
4. Master Bedroom: should always be in the South West (Guest Bedroom in North West, Child Bedroom in South or West and compromise position would be in South East or North East & Bedroom for parents who are above age 55 yrs in North East).
5. Toilet (WC): should be between West to North West.
6. Bathroom: should be between North to East.
7. Brahma region (Centre Zone) should be kept empty.

8. Abode of God (Temple in the house) should be anywhere between North to East direction but gives exceptionally good results when kept in North east region of the Vaastu.

9. Cuts: they always have negative influence on the vaastu.

If the residential vaastu is as per the above points then it has a positive impact on the people living in that vaastu and also on the owner increase the vaastu is given on lease. But increase the vaastu is not as per the above points then it has negative influence on the people living in that vaastu and also on the owner increase the vaastu is given on lease but these negative effects can be nullified and transformed into positive effects by using various yantras and pyramids and most importantly without breaking the existing structural (interior) layout of the vaastu. When we analyse the four flats on the same floor of any particular building, one of them is the best and one of them is the worst and the other two will be medium as per Vaastu shastra. In order to ensure the best return on your investment one should always get the property analysed by a Vaastu shastra expert. Along with this you can have the complete interior layout done with colour schemes as per Vaastu shastra to ensure peace, prosperity, harmony, success and good health.
